**MIN 1: 15/11/2020: PRELIMINARY:**

The meeting was called in order by the CDA and was officially opened with a muslim word of prayer from Mr. Famau Mhamed. It was followed by self introduction. The community development assistant welcomed the Malindi Municipal manager.

**MIN 2: 15/11/2020: PUBLIC SENSITIZATION**

The municipal manager thanked and welcomed all members present and introduced the agenda of the day. He further took the participants through the projects, he told the meeting that the project was funded by the world bank through the collaboration of the National and County Governments. The project is implemented at the Municipality of Malindi and the project name is construction of drainage system. In his statements he said that he is thankful of the project since it will solve the drainage menace within the Municipality. The proposed project started from Malindi roundabout and is expected to drain at the Indian Ocean besides Lawfords hotel.

The municipal Manager then welcomed the sociologist. The sociologist took the participants through the importance of the sensitization being a platform where all community members are called on for participation in giving out suggestions, concerns and opinion over the project.

She emphasized that all views and contributions from the community members are welcomed will be incorporated to make the project a success and for project sustainability. She told the meeting that implementation of project is a beginning of development and after project completion, there is the sustainability part which tends to make sure that the project benefits the future generations, can only be achieved through community participation. All members accepted and offered to support the project fully.

The municipal manager promised the community that he will bring on board all the experts for better explanation and understanding before the project is implemented. He further promised them that project implementation committee and grievance redress committee will be formed through a public participation modality with their roles and responsibilities stipulated.

Azam Rashid, a beach safety volunteer stated that, despite the project having many benefits but still will have more negative impacts mostly on the environmental and social aspect during construction and operational phase. He emphasized that it would be good if an environmentalist would be presented so as to mainstream the negative impacts thus provision of sustainable remedies.

The manager assured the meeting of the presence of the Environmentalist.
